

A good time to consider a heat pump loan

with the hot summer soon to become a distant memory, it won't be long before we'll be wearing extra layers of



We're prepared to help, should you decide to move

forward with such a project. Our heat pump loan program has served a host of co-op members through the years. Financing is available at a favorable interest rate of 7.5 percent, and the installment payments can be included on the member's monthly electric bill. Members who wish to participate would need to own both the dwelling and the land upon which it resides.

A complete description of the loan program can be summed up in a comparatively short list of "bullets." I'm pleased to reproduce that list below:

Loan amounts

- Minimum amount \$1,000
- Maximum amount (stick-built homes)
 - One heat pump \$10,000
 - Two heat pumps \$15,000
 - Geothermal heat pump \$20,000
- Maximum amount (mobile homes)
 - One heat pump \$8,000

Payback periods

- Loans less than \$1,500 42 month
- ▶ Loans more than \$1,500 60 months
- ▶ Geothermal heat pump loans

84 months



To qualify, the new heat pump would need to have a SEER rating of at least 15 for a stick-built house and a 14-or-greater SEER rating for a mobile home. Completion of the necessary forms related to the loan transaction would also be required. Payment of a small fee to cover the costs of filing the UCC forms would round out the associated paperwork.

Blue Ridge has a list of several dozen approved HVAC dealers who are enthusiastic participants in this loan program. These businesses are conveniently located all across the cooperative's service area, and we'll be glad to provide that information for you.

As I bring this report to a close, I want to note that geothermal heat pumps are an important part of this financing program. There's a great deal of emphasis today on green power and renewables, and geothermal can certainly be included among the ranks of those environmentally friendly technologies. As a service to our members, Blue Ridge is pleased to lend support to the employment of this energy-saving system.
